Paul Celan Paul Celan (1920-1970) was born in Czernowitz, Bukovina, and is considered the greatest German-language poet of the second half of the twentieth century. He survived the Holocaust and settled in Paris in 1948, where he lived and wrote until his suicide in 1970. His collections include *Poppy and Memory* and *Homestead of Time*, but he is best known for his poem "Todesfuge" ("Death Fugue").

Among his most well-known and often-anthologized poems from this time is "Fugue of Death." The poem opens with the words "Black milk of daybreak we drink it at evening we drink it at midday and morning we drink it at night" and it goes on to offer a stark evocation of life in the Nazi death camps.
